**School Uniform for 2011 – 2012**

**Female Students**

**Warm Weather Uniform**

*August 15<sup>th</sup> – October 24 and April 9 – June 1st*

- Shirt**           6<sup>th</sup> grade – Light Blue button front short sleeve shirt  
7<sup>th</sup> grade – Yellow button front short sleeve shirt  
8<sup>th</sup> grade – White button front short sleeve shirt  
Solid white undershirt with no graphics or color allowed  
No thermal undershirts worn under shirt  
All shirttails must be tucked in at all times
- Pants**           Navy – blue or khaki pants or shorts ONLY  
Brown or black leather belt with silver buckle
- Pants must fit properly at the waist
  - Pants may not be cut, torn, or altered in any way
  - Belts must be worn at all times
  - Belts may not be cut, altered, drawn or written on in any kind of way
  - Belts should be a solid color with a smooth surface
  - No thermals are to be worn under shorts
- Skirts**           Plaid (yellow & blue ONLY) or khaki – knee length  
Knee or ankle length socks (blue/white) ONLY  
No leggings are to be worn under skirt
- Shoes**           White tennis shoes/black or brown Mary Janes  
White socks
- Must have closed back and toe shoes, no ballerina flats, no mix-match shoes
  - Shoes may not be cut, altered, drawn or written on in any way
  - Laces must be solid white; no colors
  - Socks must be worn; no mix-match colors

**Winter Uniform**

*October 23 – April 4*

- Shirt**           6<sup>th</sup> grade – Light blue button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
7<sup>th</sup> grade – Yellow button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
8<sup>th</sup> grade – White button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
Solid white undershirt only, with no graphics or color allowed  
No thermal undershirts worn under shirt  
All shirttails must be tucked in at all times

- Sweater** Navy blue crew neck sweater with official school logo patch
- Pants** Navy – blue or khaki pants  
Brown or black leather belt with silver buckle
- Pants must fit properly at the waist
  - Pants may not be cut, torn, or altered in any way
  - Belts must be worn at all times
  - Belts may not be cut, altered, drawn or written on in any kind of way
  - Belts should be a solid color with a smooth surface
- Skirts** Plaid (yellow & blue ONLY) or khaki – knee length  
Uniform tights (black, blue, white); No lace tights  
No leggings are to be worn under skirt
- Shoes** White tennis shoes/black or brown Mary Janes  
Black or brown Mary-Jane shoes with skirt ONLY
- Must have closed back and toe, no ballerina flats, no mix-match shoes
  - Shoes may not be cut, altered, drawn or written on in any way
  - Laces must be solid black or white; no colors
  - Socks must be worn; no mix-match colors
- Jackets** Solid navy, casual or dress jackets with/without hood
- Must zip or button up
- Jewelry** Stud earrings (Only) for girls
- The following items are NOT allowed:
- Earrings larger than a stud
  - Dangling earrings
- Bracelets** The following items are NOT allowed:
- Colored, metal or ceramic clanking bracelets
  - Bracelets with messages that are offensive, vulgar, or which disrupts or substantially interferes with the educational process.
- Hairpiece** Solid uniform color hair pieces or matching plaid uniform hair pieces ONLY
- Hair** Should be combed neatly at all times

**Every Wednesday – Dress Up Day**

- Shirts** 6<sup>th</sup> grade – Light blue button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
7<sup>th</sup> grade – Yellow button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
8<sup>th</sup> grade – White button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
Solid white undershirt only, with no graphics or color allowed  
No thermal undershirts worn under shirt  
All shirttails must be tucked in at all times
- Skirts** Plaid (yellow & blue) or khaki ONLY
- Tie** Solid blue or plaid (long or criss-cross)
- Socks** Ankle/knee length or uniform tights (blue or white ONLY)
- Shoes** Black/brown Mary-Janes/dress shoes (ONLY)  
Must have closed back and front, no ballerina flats, no mix-match shoes

### **Male Students**

#### Warm Weather Uniform

*August 16<sup>th</sup> – October 22 and April 5 – May 27*

- Shirt** 6<sup>th</sup> grade – Light blue button front short sleeve shirt  
7<sup>th</sup> grade – Yellow button front short sleeve shirt  
8<sup>th</sup> grade – White button front short sleeve shirt  
Solid white undershirt with no graphics or color allowed  
No thermal undershirts worn under shirt  
All shirttails must be tucked in at all times
- Pants** Navy-blue or khaki pants or shorts ONLY  
Brown or black leather belt with silver buckle
- Pants must fit properly at the waist
  - Pants may not be cut, torn, or altered in any way
  - Belts must be worn at all times
  - Belts may not be cut, altered, drawn or written on in any kind of way
  - Belts should be a solid color with a smooth surface
  - No thermals are to be worn under shorts
- Shoes** White tennis shoes  
White socks
- Must have closed back and toe
  - Shoes may not be cut, altered, drawn or written on in any way
  - Laces must be solid white; no colors
  - Socks must be worn; no mix-match colors
- Hair** Should be combed neatly at all times
- No beads
  - Hair accessories should be limited to black rubber bands

## **Winter Uniform**

*October 23 – April 4*

- Shirt**            6<sup>th</sup> grade – Light blue button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
7<sup>th</sup> grade – Yellow button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
8<sup>th</sup> grade – White button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
Solid white undershirt only, with no graphics or color allowed  
No thermal undershirts worn under shirt  
All shirttails must be tucked in at all times
- Sweater**        Navy blue crew neck sweater with official school logo patch
- Pants**            Navy-blue or khaki pants  
Brown or black leather belt with silver buckle
- Pants must fit properly at the waist
  - Pants may not be cut, torn, or altered in any way
  - Belts must be worn at all times
  - Belts may not be cut, altered, drawn or written on in any kind of way
  - Belts should be a solid color with a smooth surface
- Shoes**            White tennis shoe or black/brown casual dress shoe
- Jackets**           Solid navy, casual or dress jackets (with/without hood)
- Must zip or button up
- Jewelry**           No earrings, necklace, or bracelets

Boys are not allowed to wear earrings in school. If they pierce their ears and cannot remove the earring for fear of infection, they will have to cover the earring with a band aid while at school until such time it is safe to remove (period not exceeding 2 weeks).

- Hair**            Should be combed neatly at all times
- No beads
  - Hair accessories should be limited to black rubber bands

## **Every Wednesday – Dress Up Day**

- Shirt**            6<sup>th</sup> grade – Light blue button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
7<sup>th</sup> grade – Yellow button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
8<sup>th</sup> grade – White button front (short/long sleeve) shirt  
Solid white undershirt only, with no graphics or color allowed  
All shirttails must be tucked in at all times
- Pants**            Navy-blue or khaki pants  
Brown or black leather belt with silver buckle

- Pants must fit properly at the waist
- Pants may not be cut, torn, or altered in any way
- Belts must be worn at all times
- Belts may not be cut, altered, drawn or written on in any kind of way
- Belts should be a solid color with a smooth surface
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**Tie** Solid navy blue neck/bow tie – clip-on ONLY

**Socks** Black/Brown dress socks

**Shoes** Black/brown dress casual

### **Body Piercings**

Body Piercings are only allowed for religious purposes.

### **PARENTS**

**Gym uniforms will be required by every student to be worn during gym class. P.E.uniform should be purchased from authorized vendors. Additional information will be provided on purchase location and price.**

### **Out of Uniform**

Procedure for Uniform Violations

Any student who is not wearing the proper school uniform will incur a check mark on their discipline record resulting in a uniform infraction.

The student will be requested to remedy the cause of the violation immediately

If the cause of the violation cannot be remedied on-the-spot, the student will be referred to the Student Management office for assistance.

The Student may be loaned the proper piece of clothing if available in the proper size. The loaned clothing should be laundered, and returned to school the following day.

If Student Management cannot help with the uniform issue, parents/guardians will be contacted to bring the proper uniform clothing to school.

Depending on the piece of clothing in question and on the frequency of the uniform infractions, the student may be asked to wait for the parent/guardian outside of the classroom in an area designated by the Student Management Staff.

Chronic disregard for the uniform policy will result in progressive disciplinary consequences.

## **Tattoos**

Tattoos or body markings deemed offensive, vulgar, or which disrupts or substantially interferes with the educational process are prohibited.

At school, Tattoos are to be covered by clothing and/or by any other means such as bandages, etc.

Students openly displaying tattoos and other body markings will report to the Student Management office in order to help them cover them.
